

# Elderwood Village Subdivision Stormwater Management Facility

---

## LOCATION

The Elderwood Village subdivision stormwater management facility is an existing facility located in the Liberty Reservoir Watershed. The pond is currently functioning as a water quality pond for the subdivision that is located near Monroe Avenue and Habitat Road.

## DESCRIPTION

Due to the poor condition of the pond, the County retrofitted the facility to bring it up to current standards thereby ensuring that the facility is capturing all of the drainage area intended to drain into the facility.

- Construction completed in October 2009.

## UPDATES

### September 2009

- Minor erosion occurred from a heavy rain event. Repairs were made and silt fence has since been removed.

### June 2009

- The contractor just completed the headwall installation onsite.

### March 2009

- The contractor is on-site installing sediment control measures.

### January 2009:

- The Elderwood Village HOA conveyed to Carroll County 0.46 acres for the retrofit of the stormwater management pond.
