

2010 FLU AND PNEUMONIA CLINIC SCHEDULE

The Carroll County Health Department will be offering Flu and Pneumonia vaccine to families (children 6 months and older) on the following dates and times. Children must have a consenting adult attend the clinic with them.

The 2010-2011 vaccine provides protection against A/H1N1 (pandemic) influenza and two other influenza viruses-influenza A/H3N2 and influenza B.

“Flu Shots” and Flu Mist® will be available at all the above listed clinics.

CHARGES: Flu Vaccine - \$20.00 for all persons not eligible for Medicare Part B.

**Medicare will be billed for Medicare Part B participants. Medical Assistance will be billed for persons who are eligible. Payment by Cash and Check only.

Pneumonia Vaccine - \$57.00 for all persons under 65 who have a doctor’s order.

Medicare will be billed for eligible persons age 65 and older. Medical Assistance will be billed when applicable.
