Approved by the District for Continuous Lots**

Standard Erosion Sediment Control Plan with Grading Requirements for Single Lots.

- I) This standard erosion and sediment control plan may be used of a detail plan for earth disturbances where all of the following condition are met:
 - B) The owner, builder, or developer is not the same owner, builder, or developer of any contiguous lots undergoing development, with a total disturbed of all lots not exceeding 30,000 square feet.


On road construction only erosion and sediment control plans, when the owner, builder, developer are the same for any contiguous lots undergoing development with a total disturbance of all lots exceeding 30,000 square feet; an approved plan must be obtained from Carroll Soil Conservation District.


