Effective Date: January 1, 2009

**Issue: Clarification to the Applicability Section, 115-2-A of Chapter 115**


- (1) Any person who subdivides, or property which is subdivided after December 8, 1992;
- (2) Any person who performs any other regulated activity which results in the cumulative disturbance of 40,000 square feet or greater, or any property on which such regulated activity is performed.

**Any person who subdivides and all existing lots of record will need to address Chapter 115, if disturbance exceeds 40,000 square feet, regardless of when the lot was created.**




